I am writing because I care about protecting future generations and the environment from Hanford's contamination. I care about worker, public, and environmental safety and support efforts to prevent catastrophic failure at the Hanford site. I also believe in transparency and accountability.

Thank you for considering my comments:

- Look at other options to stabilize these specific sites before filling them with grout, especially options that would make removal of the contamination easier, safer and happen sooner.
- Don't grout the sites and walk away. I need more assurance that the
 plutonium contaminated waste will be removed, treated, and disposed to
 isolate it from the environment and public.
- **Default to Non-Time Critical Removal Actions in the future** (unless it is a site at imminent risk of failure). Non-Time Critical Removal Actions require site-specific analysis and deliberation process that increases transparency and involves the public earlier in the decision-making process.
